Since our first gathering in 2014, we have had over 9,750 attendees at our annual gathering and regional events, featuring 600+ speakers. **Last year we had over 1,250 attendees from 28 different states and 7 countries.** We have become **the gathering** for thought leadership, innovation and the next generation of healthcare leaders. Our attendee profile is the following, 36% were CXOs, Founders, Executive Directors or Presidents. 26% held the title of Vice President, AVP, Senior VP, Director. 13% were Students and Graduate Students with another 5% representing the Media, Communications and Marketing specialist.

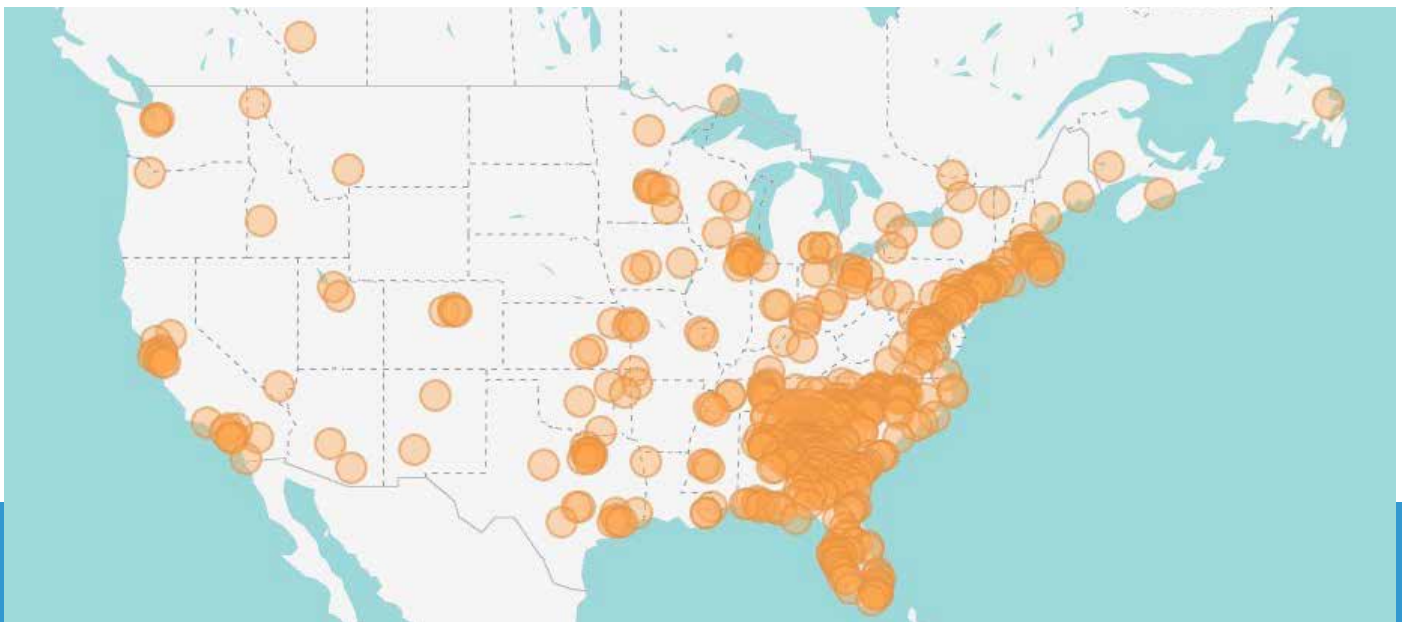
